
Klal Yisroel was so excited to be a part of building the Mishkan; they had to be restrained from giving away their valuables!





Parents will be scheduling their own appointments via our Infograsp computer system, accessible under the Parents tab on our website. Step by step instructions are attached to the email.

On Monday evening, Bais Yaakov conferences will be at 123 Industrial while Early Childhood & Elementary Boys will be at 1333 Broad Street. If applicable, when scheduling for both programs, please make sure to allow yourself enough time to travel from one location to the other.

The appointment website will be open for scheduling starting Tuesday, March 1st, at 9:00 a.m. and will close for scheduling on Friday, March 4^h, at 10:00 a.m.

Please keep in mind the following points:

- Families with 3 or more children attending the Cheder can register one day early beginning on Monday, February 28th, at 3:00 p.m.
- If unable to keep an appointment, please log in to the system again and cancel (unreserve) it, making it available for other parents.
- If unable to attend, please be in touch with your child's teacher(s) to schedule an alternate way to be in contact.
- Parents who do not have internet access may contact Rabbi Kagan while scheduling is open to assist in setting up appointments.

Due to this tight scheduling, it is necessary for us to ask the teachers to end the conferences at the end of the 10 minute slot regardless of what time the meeting began. Should a conversation need to be continued, please arrange a follow up phone meeting.




PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES SIGN UP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Go to the Parents tab on our website/PTC Signup.
- 2. If you know your User Name and Password, enter it now and skip to step #4
- 3. If you do not remember your password or if this is the first time you are signing in, you will need to set it up.
 - a. Click on the Forgot Password or User Name button.
 - b. Enter your User Name
 - Each parent in a household has a User Name
 - Your User Name is: your firstname.lastname.cby.p (e.g. Mark.Smith.CBY.P).
 - c. Click on the <u>Get Reset Code</u> button
 - d. An email will be sent with a link to reset your password.
- 4. Click on Parent Teacher Conferences
- 5. Select the conference you will be attending.
- 6. You will see your child's teachers and the times that they are available. Click the plus sign (+) on the right hand side of the screen to reserve a time slot.



7. The chosen time will appear in green under the Reserved section. If you wish to cancel or change your appointment time, click the X button on the right hand side of the screen.



- 8. If a child has the same teacher for more than one class or two or more of your children have the same teacher, then you will be permitted to schedule multiple slots for that teacher.
- 9. Families with two households may wish to visit the teachers together; each parent may sign up for the same time slot. Alternatively, each parent may schedule their own appointment time.
- 10. After choosing your appointment times click on <u>Email Schedule</u> and a copy of your appointment will be sent to the primary email address we have on record.
- 11. Click the Home button on the top left corner and then Logout.
- 12. Please bring your appointment schedule along with you to conferences as it includes the rooms your meeting(s) will be held in.
