This week's parsha begins with a special מצוה for Kohanim to guard themselves and their children from טומאת מת.

Interestingly, this is one of the few sources in the Torah for the broader mitzvah of chinuch, emphasizing to us the critical role of purity in raising children as 'עובדי ה'.

The Ibn Ezra points out that because of their elevated status, Kohanim have a special mitzvah in this regard.

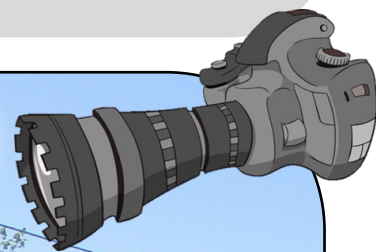
Since their role is more elevated, they must hold themselves and their children to a more elevated standard.

Today, when the majority of Klal Yisroel is not privileged to a yeshiva education, we are the כהנים of society and must also hold ourselves to a higher standard.

Our purity is what distinguishes us as Hashem's most elevated servants.

The ממלכת כהנים וגוי קדוש!

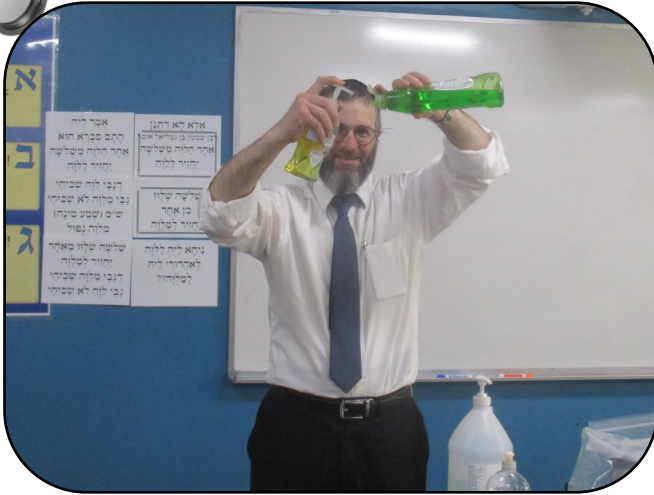

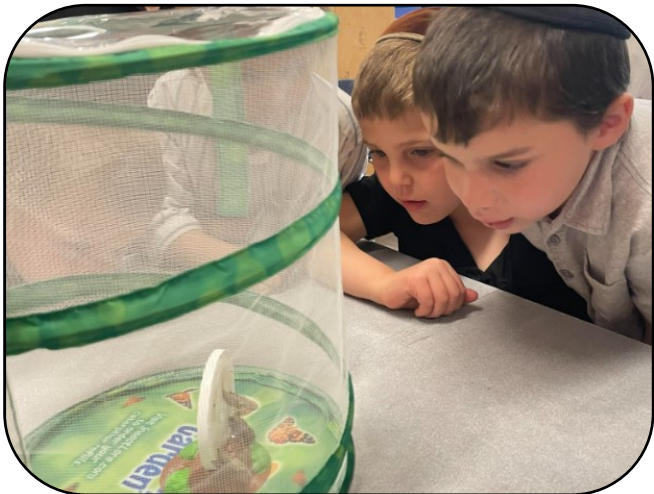

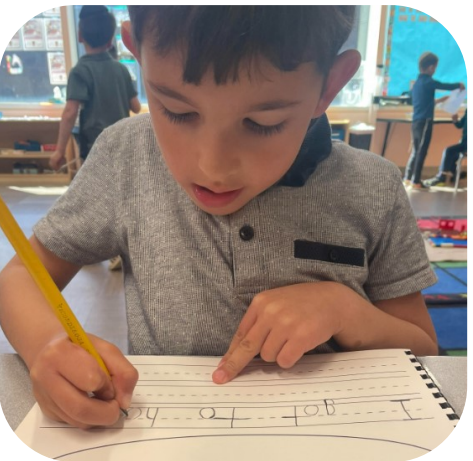
